Results from the Anthropological Investigation of Human Bone Remains from Excavations on UPI 5040 Section of Antique Necropolis of Apolonia Pontica

The study includes results from the investigation of human bone remains from two complexes with inhumation and three ones with cremation burial ritual, investigated during excavations of a section of the antique necropolis of Apolonia Pontica, situated in the area of Kalfata-Budzhaka, included in recent building activity. The investigated materials shed light to the history of the population, which inhabited the antique town in the 3rd-5th c. BC.
